

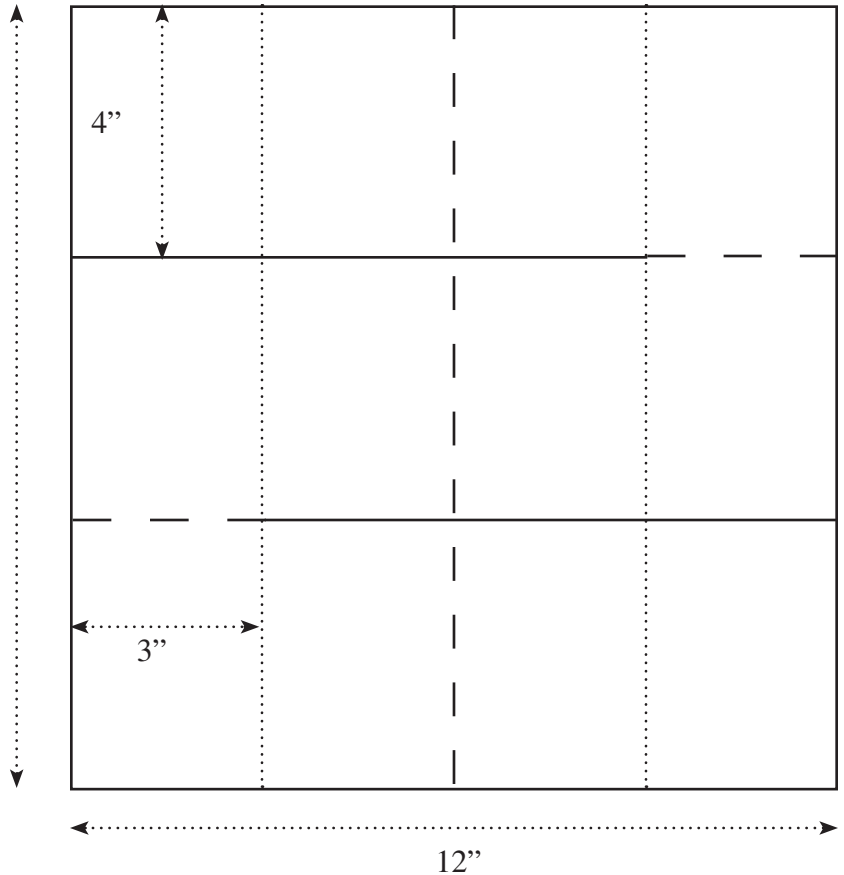
JanTink's One Little Book from One Piece of Paper

I adapted a pattern I learned from Carol Duvall to make this little book.

These templates show 12" x 12" paper at a reduced scale. BUT this folding technique will work on ANY size piece of paper. You just need to remember that you have to have an even number of divisions on each horizontal line and each division must have the same measurements or it will not fold correctly.

Legend

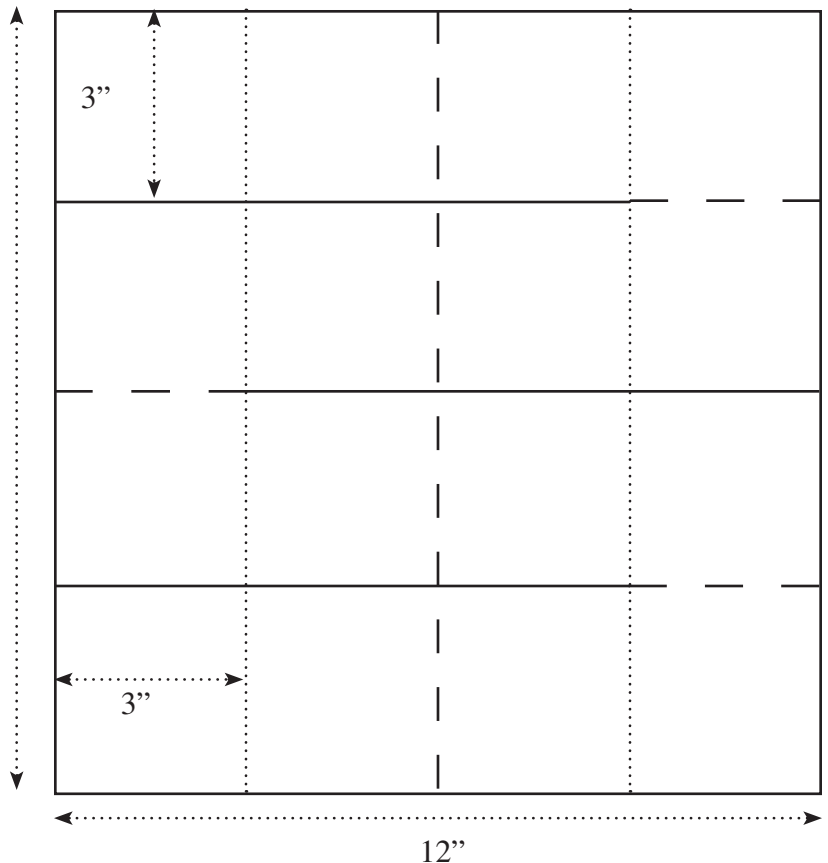
Cut	—————

After you fold your paper, cut your album cover to be 1/2 inch wider than the album (4.5 inches for the album below) and 2 inches larger than the height of the pages x 2 (8 inches) if you want a flap. I reserved 1.5 inches for the flap. There will be 1/4" around the edges of the paper. The first and last "page" are adhered to the cover.

This album uses the top template. I rounded the corners of the flap and used a sliding belly band to keep the album closed.
